

Dear Highlawn,

By now you have probably seen the television and internet adds trying to get everyone "ready for the holidays." The rush to put Christmas Trees on display now stretches as early as September. The culture we live in seems to be built out of a desire to make us feel as though, unless we take advantage of something RIGHT NOW, we will be missing out. But the opportunities that we need to really take advantage of are seldom the ones we see advertised on the screen.

The Bible has two striking examples of being so caught up in working for a goal that we miss out on the reason behind that goal. Martha bustled about her kitchen trying to make Jesus feel at home, yet was so caught up in the work that she missed out on actually spending time with Him. In Revelation when Jesus dictates a letter to the church at Ephesus, He acknowledges their work and yet rebukes them because they "have abandoned the love (they) had at first." (2:4) In simpler language, they were so invested in the business of the Kingdom they did not have enough time for the King.

It is too often an occurrence, in our commercialized age, that we place so much value in material possessions (the right food and the perfect gifts) we work ourselves into a frenzy and forget about the very people we are trying to love. We give ourselves to our work and to our shopping while leaving only our exhaustion to give to our families at home and at the church.

Being in service to others and showing hospitality to our loved ones is a matter of balance. We want to do and to give our best, but too often all our kids, our neighbors, and our church family wants is us. I encourage all of you to budget your calendars as you would your checkbooks and save time for your families at home and at church.
