- Black Debt/Sin/Scarcity/Death
- Pale Green Illness/Plague

The First Seal: Conquest (v.1-2)

- Λευκός (Leukos): Light, Brilliant White
- τόξον (Toxon): A Bow (Semicircular Shape)
- στέφανος (Stephanos): Crown of Victory
 - (To Twine or Wreath)
- νικῆσι νικάω (Nikon, Nikao): Overcome, Conquer, Prevail

Three Interpretations:

- To Assume Rulership Over (Wrong Crown)
- To Dismantle the Existing Power Structures
 - o Political
 - o Social/Religious
 - o Economic
- To Destabilize Utterly
 - o Anarchy
