

The Wedding Feast of the Lamb (v. 1-10):

- A Shouts of Acclimation
 - o Alleluia: Babylon Has Been Judged
 - o Alleluia: Babylon Will Never Rise Again
 - o Alleluia: 24 Elders (Amen “So Say We All”)
 - o Alleluia: Our God Reigns
- Angel Denies Worship of Himself (Cf. Isa. 14)
 - o John Overcome with Emotion
 - o Offers Reverence to the Angel (Holy Messenger)
 - o Angel Instructs to Worship Only God (Cf. Col. 2:18; Heb. 1:14)

Note: The number 4 holds the prophetic significance of “creation” (material universe). All creation shouts praise to God. Also, this is the last mention of 24 elders of the Church. Only the Bride of Christ is mentioned from this point.

The Bride of Christ:

Redeeming and Reclaiming the Land (v. 11-13)

- Review Isaiah 61 (v. 1-5)
 - o The Ministry of the Messiah (v. 1-2f)
 - o The Conquest of the Messiah (v. 2ff-11)
 - o The Day of Vengeance of God
 - o Centered on Israel: “Zion” (Cf. Rom. 11:11-31)
 - o Messiah Restores the Kingdom
- The Fifth Horseman
 - o Fulfillment of His Oath (Acts 1:11)
 - o Completion of the Messianic Mandate Is. 61
 - o Final Restoration of Creation to Creator

Redeeming and Reclaiming the Land (Cont.)

- Prophetic Imagery
 - o White Horse (Victory/Conquest)
 - o Called “Faithful and True” (Holy)
 - o Eyes of Fire (Sees All/Judgement)
 - o Many Crowns (Diadems: Ruling Crowns)
 - o Double Edged Sword (Word of God)
 - o Rod of Iron (Scepter that Shatters Clay)
Cf. Psalm 2:9
Trans: “Rule with...” or “Shepherd with...”
 - o Accompanying by the Victorious
(Ref. Jude 1:14; Zech. 14:5)
(White Horses/White Robes)
Angels (Cf. Mt. 13:41; 25:31; 2 Thess. 1:7)
Saints (Cf. 1 Thess. 3:13; 2 Thess. 1:10;
Heb. 2:10; Col. 3:4; Zech. 14:5)
 - o New Name only Know to Himself (?)
 - o Robe Dipped in Blood (Ref. Is 63:1-6)
 - o Declared Supreme Ruler of All

The Defeat of the Nations (v. 17-21):

- Feast of Victory
 - o Redistribution of Political Power
 - o Saints Become Rulers Under Christ
- The Battle Before the Kingdom is Established
 - o Cf. Ps. 2:1-9
 - o Nations Going to War with God
 - o Massing in the Promised Land (Dan. 11:45)
 - o Remnant Cried for Christ’s Return
(Hos. 5:15)
- The Defeat of The Enemy
 - o The World Ruler and False Prophet
Condemned while Alive
 - o Their Followers Executed in Judgement
 - o This is Before the White Throne (Ch. 20)
 - o Cf. Zech. 14:1-21
