Variation: Refers to the Kingdom of Heaven Only Spiritual Warfare vs. Temporal Conflict Often Associated with Established/Liturgical Churches **Postmillennial:** The Kingdom will be Established Prior to Christ's Return - The Kingdom will be a 1,000 Year Period, where the Christian Influence Becomes Politically Dominant After the Church has Triumphed Over the Structural Evils of the Earth, Christ will Physically and Visibly
