The Realm of the Dead ἄδης "Hades" Hell (Inferred in some places) The Abode of the Dead "Sheol" שאול Wicked sent there for Punishment (Inf.) (Outline of Biblical Usage) ταρταρόω "Tartaro" (Tartarus) The subterranean region, doleful and dark, regarded by the ancient Greeks as the abode of the wicked dead, where they suffer punishment for their evil deeds; it answers to הּוֹם גּי Gehenna of the Jews (OBU) παράδεισος "Paradeisos" Paradise Lit. Grand enclosure or preserve. A garden, pleasure ground (grove, park) The part of Hades which was thought by the later Jews to be the abode of the souls of the pious until the resurrection: but some understand this to be a heavenly paradise (OBU) Abraham's Bosom: To "be in Abraham's bosom" thus meant to enjoy happiness and rest (Mat 8:11; Luk 16:23) at the banquet in Paradise.
