Week of Days Shabbat
Week of Weeks Shavuot
Week of Years Sabbatical Year
7 Sabbath Years (+1) Year of Jubilee

- All Land Reverts to Designated Tribe/Family
 - All Slaves are Freed
 - All Debts are Forgiven

Passover:

- Lamb is Examined on Nisan 10
 - o No Imperfections (Spot nor Blemish)
 - o No Broken Bones
- Offered at Dusk Leading into 14th
- Commemorates the Passing of the Death Angel

- Israel Divided Into 4 Camps Surrounding the Levites
- Judah (Issachar, Zebulun) East: 186,400

- Ephraim (Manasseh, Benjamin) West: 108,100
Ox

- Dan (Asher, Naphtali) North: 157,6000

Kedesh-Barnea:

- 12 Israelite Men Do Reconnaissance into Canaan
- 10 Were Fearful and Spoke Against the Lord
- 2 Remained Faithful
- God Threatens to Wipe Out Israel (Num. 14)
- Moses Intercedes on Israel's Behalf
- Israel Spent 40 Years While That Generation Perished
- Caleb & Joshua Remained to the Conquest
