

The Changing Thrones of Canaan (Cont.):

- A Prophet Under Elisha Anoints Jehu King of Israel (9:6-10)
 - o Commissioned to Destroy the House of Ahab
 - o The Army Spreads their Cloaks before Jehu
 - o Jehu Kills both Joram & Ahaziah
 - o Joram is Thrown onto Naboth's Vinyard
 - o Ahaziah is Taken Back to Jerusalem for Burial
- Jehu Returns to Jezreel (9:30-37)
 - o Jezebel Calls Jehu a Traitor
 - o Palace Guards Throw Her Out a Window
 - o Jehu and His Men Have a Feast
 - o The Body of Jezebel is Eaten by Wild Dogs

The End of Ahab's House (Ch. 10):

- Jehu Requests the Governors of Israel Send the Descendants of Ahab to Jezreel to Contend for the Throne
 - o The Governors Declare Loyalty to Jehu
 - o 70 Descendants are Executed
 - o All Remaining Royal Officials Loyal to Ahab are Executed
 - o Also Slaughtered a Political Envoy from Judah (42 People)
- Jehu Takes Samaria
 - o Executes Any Remaining Loyalists
 - o Fanes Ba'al Worship & Promises a Great Feast
 - o All Clergy of Ba'al Dress in Ceremonial Attire
 - o All Levitical Worshippers are Excluded
 - o The Army Traps & Kills all Ba'al Worshippers
 - o The Temple of Ba'al is Destroyed
- Jeshu's Failure
 - o Did Not End the Worship of the Golden Calves
 - o Aram Annexes Israeli Territory East of the Jordan
 - o Reigned 28 Years
- Jehoahaz Became King (Ch. 13, 814-798BC)
 - o Israel Descends into Idolatry
 - o Hazael Decimates the Israeli Military
 - o Jehoahaz Calls Upon the Lord
 - o An Unnamed Deliverer Rescues Israel (Prince Jehoash?)
